Art Supplies:

18 x 24-inch Blank panels: Evolon and/or fabric
18 x 24-inch Newsprint for sketching
Fabric paints
Acrylic paints
Crayons
Fabric pens and/or Sharpie pens - various sizes
Pieces of foam and rubber bands for making dappers when using fabric paints
Paint brushes-assorted sizes
Pencils, pens, erasers
Plastic plates for palettes or recycled plastic lids
Stencils of alphabet letters
Masking tape to block out areas you want to mask off
Rulers
Small scraps of Evolon or fabric to experiment with paints and stencils

For hand sewing (optional):

Fabric - assorted colors, sizes, etc.
Pins
Embroidery thread
Needles, needle threader, thimbles
Scraps of fabric for experimenting
Scissors

Additional Supplies:

Nametags for participants
Plastic tablecloths to cover tables if needed
