Seven simple steps to engaging your community

1. Watch the Vision Quilt video in advance. It's a good idea to know what you are sharing with others so you can be an informed host.
2. Invite friends, family, neighbors to a viewing party. Set "ground rules" that require respectful, thoughtful, open discussion.
3. Prior to showing the video, distribute the Vision Quilt graphic handouts and ask participants to share their initial views about the statements in the graphics.
4. Watch the video as a group, encourage people to take notes.
5. Initiate a post-viewing discussion using notes and handouts to drive the discussion.
6. Ask group to determine next steps. How will you engage in the community to make a difference? Create an action plan.
7. Plan follow up meetings to report progress.
