Panel making

- Organizing workshops
- Making panels with students
- Putting grommets in panels

Outreach

- Contacting various interest groups: violence prevention groups, survivors, quilters, artists, physicians, faith community, public health groups, students, elected officials, poets, etc. to see if they would like to make panels or exhibit panels
- Integrating the Vision Quilt into ongoing community events, parades, vigils, etc.

Documentation

- Photographing and editing completed panels
- Recording video of individual panel makers
- Editing video footage

Organization

- Managing volunteers
- Managing individual exhibitions
- Managing individual events

Social Media, Publicity, Marketing

- Posting to Vision Quilt social media sites: Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest, Instagram
- Assist in writing press releases
- Assist in contacting media

Fundraising

- Assist in organizing fundraising events
